

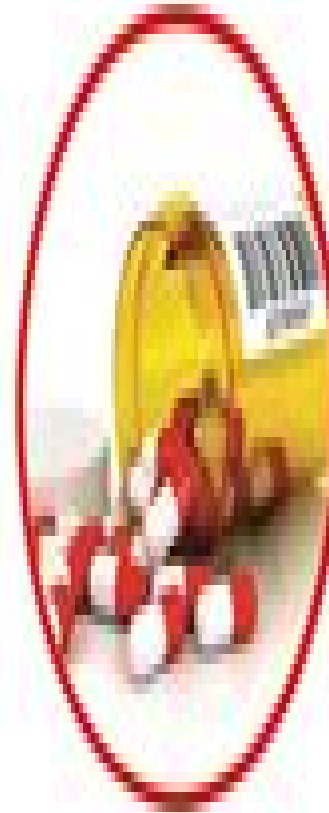

Allison,F.Xavier Pi-Sunyer,2012-12-06 Treatment outcome has certainly improved since Stunkard and McLaren Hume 1959 reviewed the literature and found that less than 25% of obese patients lost 20 pounds or more and less than 5% lost 40 pounds or more However one of the few points on which almost all obesity researchers agree is that to date our results are quite modest and we are generally unsuccessful in promoting effective weight maintenance among obese persons As the title of a more recent article *Improving long term weight loss Pushing the limits of treatment* Brownell Jeffrey 1987 emphasis added suggests many believe that we have pushed our current treatment paradigms to the limit It was with this background in mind that we organized the meeting from which these proceedings issue The purpose of the three day international
