

In his 1604 tragedy, Shakespeare explores extremely complex characters, most notably Othello and Iago. Initially, they could not be presented more differently. Othello is presented as a tragic hero who is extremely skilled in rhetoric and an extremely romantic thinker, whereas Iago is presented as a Machiavellian villain, typical of a Jacobean drama, who manipulates and deceives Othello. However, their relationship is presented as more than the classic one between protagonist and antagonist. The Actor Dominic West suggests that from experience with the role Iago, he perceives the play to be a 'sexual competition between him (Iago) and Othello' an interpretation of the characters relationship which highlights the deeply rooted homosocial bond which occasionally blurs into a homosexual one – a tension which is arguably the heart of the play. Iago's actions in 'Othello' are driven by a sense of betrayal rooted in Othello's disruption of their shared masculine bond. While Iago expects loyalty and camaraderie to take precedence in their relationship, Othello's devotion to Desdemona elevates her to an equal, threatening the hierarchy Iago values. Viewing Othello's love for Desdemona as a betrayal of their homosocial unity, Iago orchestrates his downfall as an act of vengeance, punishing him for prioritising a woman over their shared identity as soldiers and men.

There is an "eroticised bond" formed between Othello and Iago, a bond which plays into the view of the time that the Turks were "seducers." The eroticism that is shared between Othello and Iago occurs whenever the homosocial bond begins to turn into homosexual desire.

Sedgwick argues convincingly that the erotic triangle is a means of maintaining and transmitting patriarchal power and as such is a stabilising force of male-dominated societies. This stability, however, seems to be a precarious one. According to the triangular dynamics of rivalry and cuckoldry Sedgwick has explored, *Othello* should not be a tragedy at all. Othello, Brabantio, Cassio, Roderigo and Iago are connected to each other in rivalry and putative adultery by Desdemona. In *Othello*, the cuckoldry plot is essentially the means by which men interact with each other. Perhaps Iago, being the master of manipulation, knows how he has to play on the feelings and fears of others, and he does so by placing them into several erotic triangles. It can perhaps be argued that Iago's ultimate goal is a close homosocial bonding with Othello and that the miscarriage of this plan is due to the incapability of them both to perceive each other's desires. Through Sedgwick's interpretation and theory, Iago uses the triangle as a strategy of manipulation, as a means to split up a given unity of two, most notably the loving relationship between Othello and Desdemona.

Iago's view on women is marked by cynicism, contempt and indifference. The relation between the sexes belongs to the realm of sensuality; heterosexual love is to him merely "lust of the blood and permission of the will." Such love, as expressed by Roderigo for Desdemona, is a degrading lust. Iago opposes beastly sensuality to reason and proper self-love – his ideal is "a man that [knows] how to love himself." Perhaps self-love translates
