Bakhtin's Problems of Dostoevsky's Poetics and the Ideological Problem of The Brothers Karamazov Natalie Nicole Griner, 2015 Dostoevsky's final novel The Brothers Karamazov strives to resolve the question of God's existence But many critics have acknowledged that Dostoevsky seems to present Ivan's skeptical voice with equal if not greater force than Alyosha's affirmative voice a feature of the novel that is difficult to explain in the context of Dostoevsky's avowed Christianity There is an overwhelming consensus among critics that The Brothers is a thesis novel But in order to establish the novel as a defense of faith the critic must ultimately dismiss the strength of Ivan's voice and in attempting to demonstrate that the voice of doubt prevails the critic must similarly dismiss the value of Alyosha's faith By utilizing Bakhtin's theory of polyphony I propose an interpretation of The Brothers that does not attempt to resolve this opposition Because Bakhtin's theory is often seen to sanction all interpretations as equally valid it has been used to endorse each of these mutually incompatible positions on the novel But I hope to show that the theory of polyphony is in its essence diametrically opposed to the interpretation of Dostoevsky's work as either a defense of faith or a concession to doubt Further I propose contra Bakhtin that the polyphonic novel can be thesis driven if its very thesis resides in its formal polyphony The thesis of The Brothers I argue does not resolve the question of God's existence but posits instead that the inability to resolve this question is fundamental to human nature Page iv

Margaux Whiskin,2014-01-02 Contrary to what might be expected from a philosophical novel Sterne and Diderot do not impose their own views upon the reader The author s voice is but one amongst many others Margaux Whiskin s argument hinges on Bakhtinian dialogism which can be defined as the presence of interacting voices and views In Tristram Shandy and Jacques le fataliste dialogism occurs through the narrative structure allowing for the confrontation of the contradictory discourses in the philosophical debates and enabling them to engage in dialogue instead of establishing the authorial voice as the sole valid discourse in the text Through those contradictions the philosophical content takes on a different form that of a refusal of systematic discourse Sterne and Diderot do not offer a solution to the various questions debated in their novels However they do offer a philosophical approach whereby the confrontation of contradictory ideas creates a dynamic for the pursuit of truth By engaging in dialogue and constantly opening questions where there is no single right answer Sterne and Diderot redirect the focus of the reader and invite him to perceive truth not as a destination to be reached or as a closed conclusion but as being present in the quest itself in the ongoing dialogues and debates

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The Politics of Sex, Race and Working-Class Slang in Late Second Empire French Caricature Russell Stephens, 2025-08-11 This study examines caricatures as they appeared within popular Parisian magazines in mid 19th century France at the time of the 1867 World's Fair Chapters compare the comic mockery of several of the most important satirists of this time including Am d e de No or Cham 1818 1879 as he was more popularly known and Honor Daumier 1808 1879 A major theme within the analysis is how these caricaturists secretly used argot street slang as documented in two slang dictionaries by Parisian litterateur Alfred Delvau 1825 1867 within their comic images to carry hidden encrypted messages in order to evade the censorship of the day The book focuses primarily on caricatures of Chinese visitors who were part of the 1866 diplomatic visit to Paris and images of Chinese at the 1867 Exposition Universelle showing how the satires which were published by Cham used argot to create highly sexualised images that were often racist in nature In contrast the volume proposes that Daumier used slang in his caricatures to challenge racism and to make secret reference to current political leaders and politics The book will be of interest to scholars working in art history visual culture media studies and communication studies
