yielding rich insights into Wells's career as well as broader events on the post revolutionary American frontier where Anglo Americans pushing westward competed with the Indian nations of the Old Northwest for control of territory Wells's unusual career Heath emphasizes earned him a great deal of ill will Because he warned the U S government against Tecumseh's confederacy and the Tenskwatawa's religiously mad followers he was hated by those who supported the Shawnee leaders Because he came to question treaties he had helped bring about and cautioned the Indians about their harmful effects he was distrusted by Americans Wells is a complicated hero and his conflicted position reflects the decline of coexistence and cooperation between two cultures
