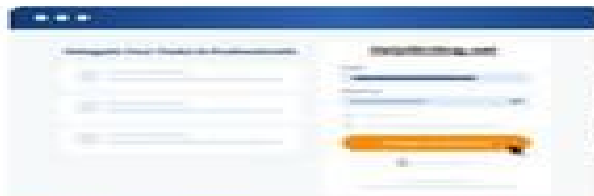
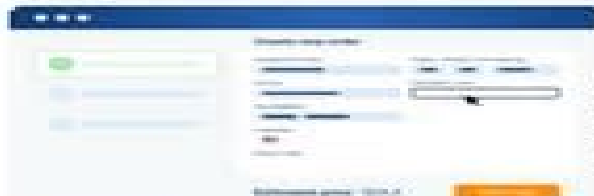

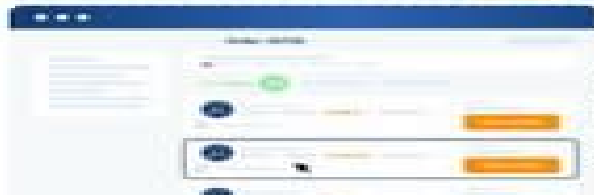
1. Step

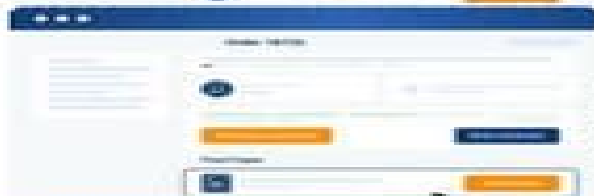

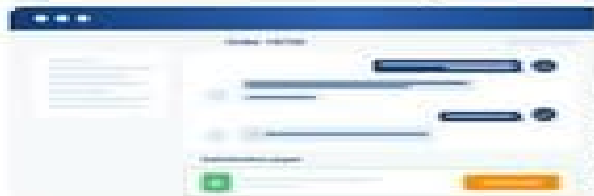
