hydrology river basin management water stress and crop growth all connected to the International Model for Policy Analysis of Agricultural Commodities and Trade IMPACT The outcomes of this part of the modeling suite are annual crop yields and global food prices under various climate change scenarios until 2050 The effects of such changes on production consumption macroeconomic indicators and income distribution are assessed using a single country dynamic Computable General Equilibrium CGE model for the Sudan Additionally we introduce yield variability into the CGE model based on stochastic projections of crop yields until 2050 The results of the model simulations reveal that while the projected mean climate changes bring some good news for the Sudan extreme negative variability costs the Sudan cumulatively between 2018 and 2050 US 109 5 billion in total absorption and US 105 5 billion in GDP relative to a historical mean climate scenario without climate change
