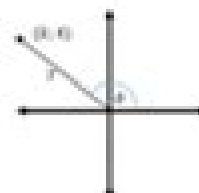
QUESTION 3

3.2 Study the following sketch and determine the value of $\cos \theta - \cos \phi$, without the use of a calculator.



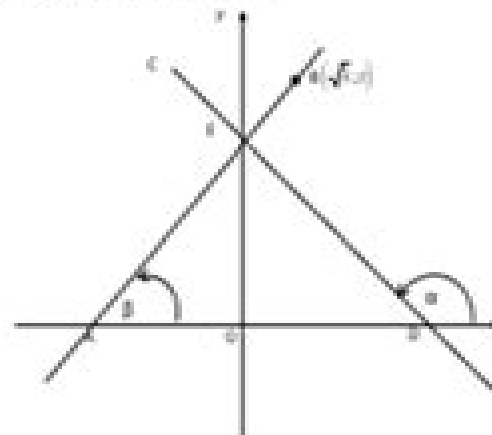
