Cold War 1947-1991

Important Terms and Events

Containment: Communism needed to be contained and isolated, or else it would spread to neighboring countries

United Nations (1945) - International organization formed after WWII to serve as a peacekeeper in world conflicts. The United States and Soviet Union used the UN to promote their beliefs during the Cold War.

Roosevelt Doctrine (1947) - U.S. policy that gave military and economic aid to countries threatened by communism. [Compassion.com](https://www.compassion.com)

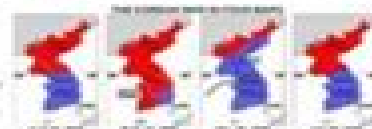
Marshall Plan (1948) - Program proposed by Gen. George Marshall to help European countries rebuild after WWII. The United States offered economic aid to the war-torn countries.

NATO (1949) - North Atlantic Treaty Organization. A military alliance formed between the United States, Canada, and ten western European countries.

Berlin Airlift - (1948-1949) operation that flew food and supplies into West Berlin after the Soviet Union cut off a blockade in 1948.

Civil Service Reform - laws passed in the 1870s and 1880s began to require government workers to take tests to work for the government and began replacing the "spoils system"

Who do people move?

Immigrants

- About 25 million European immigrants arrived in the U.S. between 1870 and 1920
- Before 1900, most immigrants came from Western and Northern Europe. These were known as the "Old Immigrants."
- An increase of Southern and Eastern immigrants occurred after 1900. They were known as the "New Immigrants" and their arrival increased social tension.
- 200,000 Chinese immigrants arrived between 1882 and 1902



Tenements - Apartments built in city slums to house large numbers of people. Many immigrants were forced to live in tenements in "slum" neighborhoods.

Cold Labor was a major problem during the Gilded Age.

Swiss Cheese - A small factory where workers work many hours in bad conditions, for little pay. Immigrants (and children) were considered cheap labor and paid very little for their work.

Triangle Shirtwaist Factory Fire - 1911 killed 146 people, mostly women. Locked doors and fire escapes were too high for them to get to the ground led to the majority of the deaths. Organized the poor working conditions, and led to federal regulations to protect workers.

Progressivism - The movement of the people, born with the founding of the Populist Party in 1892. William Jennings Bryan was their leader.

Rainy Cycles (1880s-1890s) - Farmers had struggles to be productive in the late 1880s, because of the many problems they faced:

1. Agricultural Overproduction: Farmers produced more crops, food prices fell
2. Transportation Costs: Farmers had to use Railroad to ship crops to market, the railroad company took advantage of farmers' desperate high rates

4. Drought, Natural Disasters: One bad year could wipe out a crop and the family's savings, droughts, insect infestations, and floods.

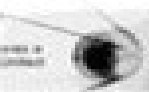
