divergence and curl are examined and tangent planes and normals in 3 and 4 dimensions are examined Wrapping up this chapter is a complete GA formulation of the general Stokes theorem for curvilinear coordinates in Euclidean or non Euclidean spaces is developed General Physics This chapter introduces a bivector form of angular momentum instead of a cross product examines the components of radial velocity and acceleration kinetic energy symplectic structure Newton s method and a center of mass problem for a toroidal segment Relativity This is a fairly incoherent chapter including an attempt to develop the Lorentz transformation by requiring wave equation invariance Lorentz transformation of the four vector STA gradient and a look at the relativistic doppler equation Electrodynamics The GA formulation of Maxwell s equation singular in GA is developed here Various basic topics of electrodynamics are examined using the GA toolbox including the Biot Savart law the covariant form for Maxwell's equation Space Time Algebra or STA four vectors and potentials gauge invariance TEM waves and some Lienard Wiechert problems Lorentz Force Here the GA form of the Lorentz force equation and its relation to the usual vectorial representation is explored.
