It just so happened with me living in a small town that paramedic was my best friend's father, Gene Deck. That's when I got my mom back, and to this day she is always there for me and is my best friend. During that time I had also lost my brother who meant the world to me.

He was my role model and was everything to me. I would wait for him every day on the porch to arrive from work. He had been though a lot himself and had went to prison
