Along with many other ancient cultures, the Ancient Greeks had a set of beliefs which helped them to understand the world around them. Within their belief system, the Greeks worshipped twelve gods and goddesses who they believed ruled the universe from Mount Olympus. They believed each of their gods and goddess represented something in particular, and so would worship each for different reasons.

Poseidon

To the Ancient Greeks, Poseidon was the God of the sea, and was also the brother of Zeus – the most powerful of all their gods. He was believed to be hot-tempered and regularly in conflict with Athena (the Goddess of wisdom and war) and Odysseus (a legendary hero made famous by the writings of Homer). He was often described as having a beard and long blue hair, riding a chariot, and carrying a trident (three-pointed spear).

The Greeks believed that Poseidon, from his beautiful palace under the sea, could cause earthquakes and storms. They would, therefore, pray to Poseidon, in the belief that they would be kept safe on voyages across the sea.
