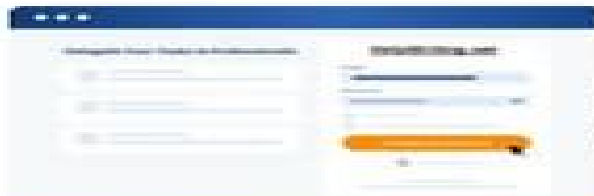
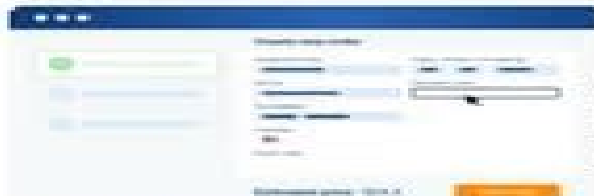

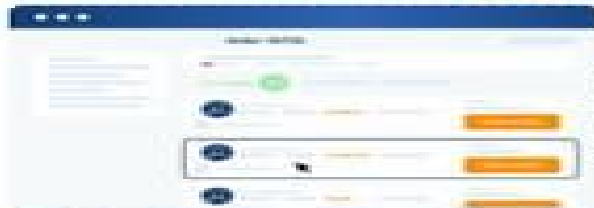
1. Step

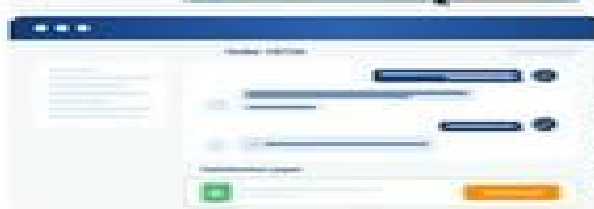
