Nursing Care of the Child with an Infection

Infants and young children are more susceptible to infection due to their immature immune system. Young children continue to have an increased risk for infections and communicable disorders because disease protection from immunization is not complete.

Health care providers need to remember to educate parents that fever is a protective mechanism the body uses to fight infection

When obtaining blood cultures, follow aseptic techniques and hospital protocol to prevent contamination. Obtain the specimen before administration of antibiotic

When administering antipyretics, proper education must be given to caregivers on appropriate dosing, concentration, dosing interval, and use of proper measuring device

Promoting proper fluid balance and reducing temperature in a febrile child are important nursing intervention when caring for a child with an infection or communicable illness

Many childhoods infectious and communicable diseases involve a rash. Rashes can be difficult to identify, so a thorough description and history from the caregiver is important

Sepsis, a systemic overresponse to infection resulting from bacteria, fungi, viruses, or parasites, can lead to septic shock. Any infant younger than 3 months old with a fever or any child with a fever accompanied by extreme lethargy, unresponsiveness, or lack of facial expressions should be seen by a physician or nurse practitioner

Many bacterial and viral infections, such as diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis, mumps, measles, rubella, varicella, and poliomyelitis, can be prevented by vaccination

Viral exanthems of childhood often present with a distinct rash pattern that assists in the diagnosis of the virus. Common childhood exanthems include exanthems subitem (roseola infantum), rubella (German measles), rubella (measles), varicella (chickenpox), and erythema infectiosum (fifth disease)
