relative to their respective time periods Together these case studies form a new framework for discussions of the historical and contemporary monitoring of religion They show that government surveillance is less predictable and monolithic than we might assume Therefore this book will be of great interest to scholars of United States religion history and politics as well as surveillance and communication studies
