# Abstract

Besides social media and networking sites, one of the more popular ways that this demand is met is through the constant updates and releases of new video games. However, in more recent times video games have not only become a form of entertainment but they are also a method through which many earn their living, whether it is their development or through larger esports tournaments where players can earn potentially millions. To put this in perspective in 2017 DOTA 2 prize pool totalled \$24.6 million. When looking at this industry one of the many struggles that the very first developers would have gone through is how to create and efficient movement system without compromising the user experience. This is especially important in top-down games like DOTA 2 or League of Legends because of the nature of their movement systems and how the players will use simple mouse clicks to administer the movement commands for their in-game characters. In this essay, I will be exploring Dijkstra's algorithm and its variant the A\* search algorithm, both of which are very popular algorithms that are used to calculate movement within these games, but before we take a look at the algorithms themselves we will have to familiarise ourselves with some key terminology.

#### The Grid Based Environment

When referring to graphs in pathfinding there are two types of graphs a sparse graph and a more grid-based environment. The sparse graph will involve a series of nodes which are points, and then the edges which will connect their nodes to show traversable or walkable paths. Whereas in a grid-based environment the nodes are interconnected and there may be some nodes which cannot be traversed. Refer to the diagram below: In the diagrams above the green node represents the current position on the object. In the sparse graph, we are limited to the paths we can take by the predetermined edges whereas in the grid-based environment all the squares are their own nodes and it is possible to move vertically, horizontally or diagonally. The grey squares are other entities and so we cannot traverse those nodes. In essence, in the grid-based environment, assuming there are no non-traversable nodes, each node is connected to eight other nodes ie, all its neighbours. For the purposes of this investigation, I will be using the grid-based environment for all because in games characters can usually move in any given direction as long as there are no non-traversable nodes in the vicinity.

## Distances

If we were moving from any given node vertically or horizontally this would equate to a particular distance. We will name this particular distance 1 unit. However, the distance to travel from one node to another diagonally is not the same distance. This is because we have to travel a greater distance to get to the node. To work out what this distance actually is we can use a simple piece of maths known as the Pythagorean theorem. This theorem states that given a right angle triangle angle the length of the hypotenuse (the side opposite the right angle) is equal to the sum of the squared...
