Countries also called for the further development of and investment in effective nationally compatible regional multi hazard early warning mechanisms To address these needs global Target g of the Sendai Framework was adopted namely to substantially increase the availability of and access to multi hazard early warning systems and disaster risk information and assessments to the people by 2030 As illustrated by recent events in Indonesia it is also vital to address the challenge of cascading hazards that pose a tsunami risk and the importance of linking tsunami early warning to a multi hazard environment However moving towards a multi hazard environment is complex and poses many challenges but can bring significant benefits in terms of efficiencies and also in recognising the links between hazards such as cascading threats We very much hope that this book will provide an important platform to address these and other challenges in addressing disaster risk as well as supporting implementation of the Sendai Framework for Disaster Risk Reduction
