Perhaps no exercise in organic chemistry is more intimidating than a synthesis problem, where you are asked to perform a series of reactions to convert a given starting material into a desired target. This manual outlines how to approach these problems on exams and how to prepare for them through study and practice. The guide is organized around the order that material is presented in the textbook Organic Chemistry, 5th edition by Janice Smith. It is designed to be picked up by students near the end of the first semester of organic chemistry, roughly equating to the conclusion of Chapter 12 in Smith's textbook. After the initial introduction (sections 1–3), reactions are presented on a chapter-by-chapter basis so this guide may be revisited periodically until the conclusion of the course.
