Among them have been issues related to population density, racial/ethnic/cultural and linguistic diversity, poverty, racism, individual and institutional, and funding levels. Although urban educators have been addressing these issues for decades, placing them under the umbrella of urban education and treating them as a specific area of practice and inquiry is relatively recent. Despite the wide adoption of the term, a consensus about its meaning exists at only the broadest of levels. In short, urban education remains an ill-defined concept.
