Same-sex marriage is the practice of marrying someone of the same sex. It is a marriage between two women or two men under the law. Most countries in the world have already legalized same-sex marriage, but not all. The Philippines is one of the countries that have yet to legalize same-sex marriage in the country. There was international research on how many people are part of the LGBTQ+ (Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, Queer, and Questioning) community. According to the research, about 10 million people are part of the LGBTQ+ community in the Philippines. This shows the support of people who are part of the LGBTQ+ in the country. Then, the question came up: Should we allow the legalization of same-sex marriage here in the Philippines? There was a survey conducted by the Social Weather Stations in that year if Filipinos are in favor of legalizing same-sex marriage. The outcome of the survey showed that 60% of Filipinos are against the legalization of same-sex marriage here in the Philippines. 30% are in favor of legalizing it and 10% of the Filipinos have not decided whether they agree or disagree on the matter. This indicates that the acceptance rate of the subject in the Philippines cannot even be considered as half since less than half the Philippines being a "gay-friendly country" (Gonzalez, 2018). The president of the Philippines, Mr. Rodrigo Duterte, also opposed the legalization of same-sex marriage here in the country that this is not an culture and same-sex marriage is not applicable here in the Philippines because we are Catholic (Gonzalez, 2017). Regardless, same-sex marriage should be legalized in the Philippines to strengthen the fundamental rights of equality and free freedom of belief and religion.

Same-sex marriage for the LGBTQ+ community has been categorized as a matter of human rights. This has sparked a long controversy leading to the dividing of citizens, especially the church. Same-sex marriage in the Philippines remains a sensitive topic because of issues like religious fundamentalism, culture, society, where same-sex marriage is considered as a way of morality and love of filial piety. However, conservative people have fought against gay, transsexual, transgender, and other who opposed to religious freedom to achieve equal rights under the law (Gonzalez, 2018).
