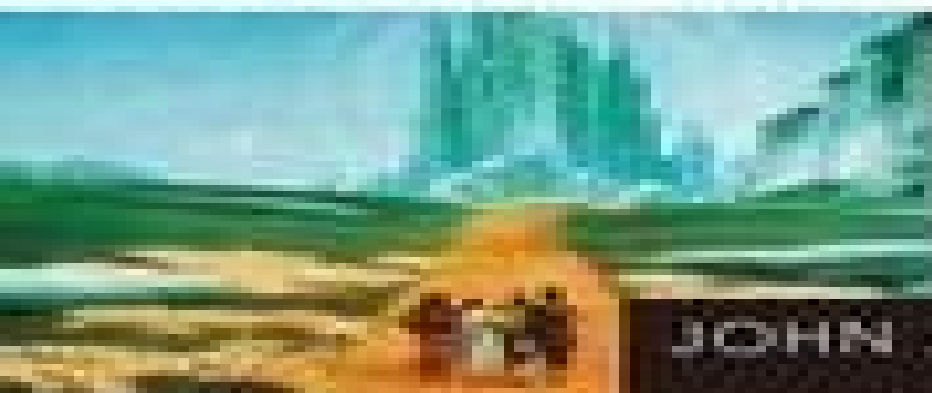

Indie Reframed Linda Badley, 2017-02-07 Explores the films practitioners production and distribution contexts that currently represent American womens independent cinema. With the consolidation of indie culture in the 21st century female filmmakers face an increasingly indifferent climate. Within this sector women work across all aspects of writing direction production editing and design yet the dominant narrative continues to construe an amateurish white male auteurs such as Quentin Tarantino or Wes Anderson as the face of indie discourse. Defying the formulaic myths of the mainstream chick flick and the ideological and experimental radicalism of feminist counter cinema alike womens indie filmmaking is neither ironic popular nor political enough to be readily absorbed into pre existing categories. This ground breaking collection the first sustained examination of the work of female practitioners within American independent cinema reclaims the difference of female indie filmmaking. Butters,2002 In early twentieth century

motion picture houses offensive stereotypes of African Americans were as predictable as they were prevalent Watermelon eating chicken thievery savages with uncontrollable appetites Sambo and Zip Coon were all representations associated with African American people Most of these caricatures were rendered by whites in blackface Few people realize that from 1915 through 1929 a number of African American film directors worked diligently to counter such racist definitions of black manhood found in films like D W Griffith s The Birth of a Nation the 1915 epic that glorified the Ku Klux Klan In the wake of the film s phenomenal success African American filmmakers sought to defend and redefine black manhood through motion pictures Gerald Butters s comprehensive study of the African American cinematic vision in silent film concentrates on works largely ignored by most contemporary film scholars African American produced and directed films and white independent productions of all black features Using these race movies to explore the construction of masculine identity and the use of race in popular culture he separates cinematic myth from historical reality the myth of the Euro American controlled cinematic portrayal of black men versus the actual black male experience Through intense archival research Butters reconstructs many lost films expanding the discussion of race and representation beyond the debate about good and bad imagery to explore the construction of masculine identity and the use of race as device in the context of Western popular culture He particularly examines the filmmaking of Oscar Micheaux the most prolific and controversial of all African American silent film directors and creator of the recently rediscovered Within Our Gates the legendary film that exposed a virtual litany of white abuses toward blacks Black Manhood on the Silent Screen is unique in that it takes contemporary and original film theory applies it to the distinctive body of African American independent films in the silent era and relates the meaning of these films to larger political social and intellectual events in American society By showing how both white and black men have defined their own sense of manhood through cinema it examines the intersection of race and gender in the movies and offers a deft interweaving of film theory American history and film history

The Gallup Poll Alec Gallup, Alec M. Gallup, Frank Newport, 2007 Pyramid Lake is one of the largest lakes in the Great Basin the terminus of the Truckee River flowing from Lake Tahoe into northern Nevada This desert oasis with a surface area of nearly two hundred square miles is a unique geological feature and was home to the Paiute for thousands of years before the arrival of explorer John C Fremont in 1844 For the Paiute it was a spiritual center that provided life sustaining resources such as the cui ui a fish unique to the lake and now endangered For the ranchers and farmers who settled on tribal lands the waters that flowed into it were necessary to raise cattle and crops Mergen tells how these competing interests have interacted with the lake and with each other from the Paiute War of 1860 to the present The lake s very existence was threatened by dams and water diversion it was saved by tribal claims favorable court decisions improved water laws and the rise of environmentalism At Pyramid Lake is about more than Indians and water wars however It is the story of railroads on the reservation and the role of federal state and private groups interested in sportfishing It is about scientists artists and tourists who were captivated by the lake s

beauty Finally it is also a story of the lake as a place of spiritual renewal and celebration Mergen grew up near its shores in the 1940s and returned frequently through the years In this cultural history he combines his personal remembrances with other source material including novels poetry newspaper and magazine journalism unpublished manuscripts and private conversations to paint a fascinating portrait of one of Nevada's natural wonders

Music in Films on the Middle Ages John Haines, 2013-10-30 This book explores the role of music in the some five hundred feature length films on the Middle Ages produced between the late 1890s and the present day Haines focuses on the tension in these films between the surviving evidence for medieval music and the idiomatic tradition of cinematic music The latter is taken broadly as any musical sound occurring in a film from the clang of a bell off screen to a minstrel singing his song Medieval film music must be considered in the broader historical context of pre cinematic medievalisms and of medievalist cinema's main development in the course of the twentieth century as an American appropriation of European culture The book treats six pervasive moments that define the genre of medieval film the church tower bell the trumpet fanfare or horn call the music of banquets and courts the singing minstrel performances of Gregorian chant and the music that accompanies horse riding knights with each chapter visiting representative films as case studies These six signal musical moments that create a fundamental visual aural core central to making a film feel medieval to modern audiences originate in medievalist works predating cinema by some three centuries

geographies of African media industries are not fixed locations cleanly separated from surrounding areas or from the wider world including Hollywood nor are they fully detachable from the mineral and hydrocarbon resources that also define them. Considering multiple scales the local the national the regional the continental the planetary this book takes stock of the physical terrain and extractive objects that Nollywood shares with other industries and that structure screen media more broadly. Topographies political economies national identities and natural resources are entwined in ways that cinema makes intelligible and that carry the potential to transform the way we see the medium itself.
