Roland Barthes: The Proust Variations Thomas Baldwin, 2019-09-06 This book concerns the variations operated by Barthes on la recherche du temps perdu over a period of three decades It reads the Proustian oeuvre through the prism of Barthes providing new readings of Proust's novel and of Barthes's own writings and revealing an intricate and inconsistent web of references and circulations between the two

Discourses of Mourning in Dante, Petrarch, and Proust Jennifer Rushworth, 2016-11-24 This book brings together in a novel and exciting combination three authors who have written movingly about mourning two medieval Italian poets Dante Alighieri and Francesco Petrarca and one early twentieth century French novelist Marcel Proust Each of these authors through their respective narratives of bereavement grapples with the challenge of how to write adequately about the deeply personal and painful experience of grief In Jennifer Rushworth's analysis discourses of mourning emerge as caught between the twin conflicting demands of a comforting readable shared generality and a silent solitary respect for the uniqueness of any and every experience of loss Rushworth explores a variety of major questions in the book including what type of language is appropriate to mourning What effect does mourning have on language Why and how has the Orpheus myth been so influential on discourses of mourning across different time periods and languages Might the form of mourning described in a text and the form of closure achieved by that same text be mutually formative and sustaining In this way discussion of the literary representation of mourning extends to embrace topics such as the medieval sin of acedia the proper name memory literary epiphanies the image of the book and the concept of writing as promise In addition to the three primary authors Rushworth draws extensively on the writings of Sigmund Freud Julia Kristeva Jacques Derrida and Roland Barthes These rich and diverse psychoanalytical and French theoretical traditions provide terminological nuance and frameworks for comparison particularly in relation to the complex term melancholia

La Tribu des clercs Rémy Rieffel, 2014-04-01. Que n'a-t-on pas dit sur le rôle des intellectuels dans la vie publique sur leur rapport au pouvoir ou sur la tribu qu'ils forment. Tour à tour accusés de ne pas se tenir leur place et de démissionner de leurs responsabilités de former une caste et d'être enfermés dans leur tour d'ivoire ils sont l'objet en France d'un véritable culte en même temps qu'ils sont traités en boucs émissaires. Mais précisément sont-ils encore ce qu'ils étaient lorsque Julien Benda publiait *La Trahison des clercs*. La crise qu'ils traversent sous la Ve République est sans nul doute l'une des plus graves qu'ils aient connues. Les révolutions progressives sur la nature des régimes communistes puis le démantèlement de la forteresse marxiste ont laissé parfois désemparés ces compagnons de route qu'ils furent souvent quand la montée en puissance des médias elle n'a pas peu contribué à bouleverser le travail intellectuel. Pour étudier cette crise d'identité Rémy Rieffel joint les mérites de l'analyse sociologique ceux de l'enquête. Il a interrogé plus de quatre-vingts de ces clercs certains sont célèbres d'autres sont influents. Leurs propos souvent caustiques toujours clairs donnent à cet ouvrage un relief singulier.

La fin des années 1970 ce maître pensait internationalement reconnu. Professeur au Collège de France, auteur de best-sellers, il traînait derrière lui une foule de disciples. Journaux et magazines se disputaient sa parole. Pourtant Barthes ne s'est jamais remis de la mort de sa mère survenue alors qu'il avait soixante et un ans. Sa mère avec qui il avait toujours vécu en compagnie de son frère. Les derniers jours de Roland Barthes a pour ambition d'emmener le lecteur dans l'intimité d'un célèbre. Le projecteur est mis sur l'homme, non sur l'œuvre. L'homme, ce misérable tas de secrets selon le mot d'André Malraux. Un tel attachement à la mémoire résulte d'une histoire familiale particulière. Pourquoi un grand esprit comme Barthes n'est-il jamais parvenu à couper le cordon ombilical. Pourquoi n'a-t-il pas réussi à passer le deuil de sa génitrice. Pourquoi s'est-il quasiment laissé mourir après un banal accident de la circulation. Plus de vingt-cinq ans après la mort de Roland Barthes, l'auteur est parti à la recherche de ses proches. Son enquête minutieuse témoigne de la fragilité du succès. Selon l'expression consacrée, Barthes avait tout pour être heureux, ses amis, il apparaissait pourtant comme le malheur vivant. Loin de déboulonner une idole, ce récit la fois pudique et impudique vise à lui restituer sa part d'humanité.

Galia Yanoshevsky montre ainsi comment les discours s'emploient fonder une esthétique et lui donner corps au-delà de la diversité des textes.

The Nouveau Roman writers have been actively involved in the theory as well as the practice of fiction participating in a series of vigorous debates on issues such as the political significance of literature, formalism and structuralism, the status of the author, etc. This study discusses Robbe-Grillet, Sarraute, Simon Butor and Ricardou analysing both the interaction of their own theory and fiction and their reactions to the work of figures such as Sartre, Barthes, Lévi-Strauss, Sollers and Kristeva.

Sociologia geral vol. 4 Pierre Bourdieu, 2023-12-13. Este o quarto volume baseado nas conferências proferidas por Pierre Bourdieu no Colóquio de France no início dos anos de 1980 sob o título Sociologia geral. Nessas palestras Bourdieu se propõe a definir e defender a Sociologia como uma disciplina intelectual e ao faz-lo introduz e esclarece todos os conceitos-chave que definiram sua abordagem intelectual distinta. Tendo elaborado os conceitos de habitus e campo em volumes anteriores, Bourdieu empreende agora uma análise das relações entre eles mostrando que os campos sociais são objetos de percepção e conhecimento para os agentes neles engajados.

Nostalgic Rebels: Politics, Aesthetics, and Selfhood in Postcolonial Morocco Khalid Lyamlahy, 2025-05-23. Mohammed Kharr Eddine (1941-1995), Abdelkader Khatibi (1938-2009) and Abdellatif Laïbi (1942-) are three of the most important francophone Moroccan writers to have emerged in the 1960s. Belonging to the Souffles generation named after the journal of culture and politics founded in 1966, they played a major role in cultural decolonization and the development of Moroccan literature. This book examines their works and legacy through the dual lenses of revolt and nostalgia. By weaving together comparative close readings of their writings with an analysis of the broader historical and political context in Morocco, the book demonstrates that these writers

have used revolt and nostalgia to address state sponsored violence grapple with uncertainties about the writing process and advance or revitalize their political and aesthetic projects In doing so this study traces a literary genealogy of political resistance aesthetic subversion and nostalgic reconstruction in postcolonial Morocco while offering a nuanced historical perspective that is closely attuned to the specificities of Moroccan postcoloniality and sensitive to individual trajectories and experiences The book covers a wide range of literary genres including poetry theater prose fiction and autobiography all analyzed through a distinctively Moroccan historical and cultural lens providing new insights into Moroccan literature and the theories of revolt and nostalgia

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
