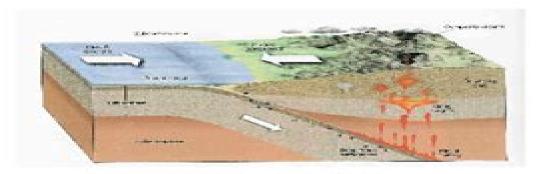


Figure 2.1- Plate boundary block diagram.

1A. Examine the cross section of a plate boundary in figures 2.1 and 2.2.
