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Eight World Cups George Vecsey, 2013-06-25 Full of humor and insight about sport and culture The pomp glory and great entertainment all get their due in Eight World Cups The Boston Globe Blending witty travelogue with action on the field and shady dealings in back rooms George Vecsey offers an eye opening globe trotting account of eight World Cups He immerses himself in the great national leagues historic clubs and devoted fans and provides his up close impressions of charismatic soccer stars like Socrates Maradona Baggio and Zidane while also chronicling the rise of the U S men's and women's teams Vecsey shows how each host nation has made the World Cup its own from the all night street parties in Spain in 1982 to the roar of vuvuzelas in South Africa in 2010 as the game in the stadium is backed up by the game in the street But the joy is sometimes undermined by those who style themselves the game's protectors **Supersizing Urban America** Chin Jou, 2017-03-15 More than one third of adults in the United States are obese The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention estimates that there are over 112 000 obesity related deaths annually and for many years the government has waged a very public war on the problem Former Surgeon General Richard Carmona warned in 2006 that obesity is the terror within going so far as to call it a threat that will dwarf 9 11 What doesn't get mentioned in all this The fact that the federal government helped create the obesity crisis in the first place especially where it is strikingly acute among urban African American communities Supersizing Urban America reveals the little known story of how the U S government got into the business of encouraging fast food in inner cities with unforeseen consequences we are only beginning to understand Chin Jou begins her story in the late 1960s when predominantly African American neighborhoods went from having no fast food chain restaurants to being littered with them She uncovers the federal policies that have helped to subsidize that expansion including loan guarantees to fast food franchisees programs intended to promote minority entrepreneurship and urban revitalization initiatives During this time fast food companies also began to relentlessly market to urban African American consumers An unintended consequence of these developments was that low income minority communities were disproportionately affected by the obesity epidemic In the first book about the U S government's problematic role in promoting fast food in inner city America Jou tells a riveting story of the food industry obesity and race relations in America that is essential to understanding health and obesity in contemporary urban America **The Birth of the Pill** Jonathan Eig, 2014-09-29 A Chicago Tribune Best Books of 2014 A Slate Best Books 2014 Staff Picks A St Louis Post Dispatch Best Books of 2014 The fascinating story of one of the most important scientific discoveries of the twentieth century We know it simply as the pill yet its genesis was anything but simple Jonathan Eig's masterful narrative revolves around four principal characters the fiery feminist Margaret Sanger who was a champion of birth control in her campaign for the rights of women but neglected her own children in pursuit of free love the beautiful Katharine McCormick who owed her fortune to her wealthy husband the son of the founder of International Harvester and a schizophrenic the visionary scientist Gregory Pincus

who was dismissed by Harvard in the 1930s as a result of his experimentation with in vitro fertilization but who after he was approached by Sanger and McCormick grew obsessed with the idea of inventing a drug that could stop ovulation and the telegenic John Rock a Catholic doctor from Boston who battled his own church to become an enormously effective advocate in the effort to win public approval for the drug that would be marketed by Searle as Enovid Spanning the years from Sanger's heady Greenwich Village days in the early twentieth century to trial tests in Puerto Rico in the 1950s to the cusp of the sexual revolution in the 1960s this is a grand story of radical feminist politics scientific ingenuity establishment opposition and ultimately a sea change in social attitudes Brilliantly researched and briskly written *The Birth of the Pill* is gripping social cultural and scientific history

Running from Office Jennifer L. Lawless, Richard L. Fox, 2015-04-08 The past two decades of politics in Washington have seen increased partisanship prolonged stalemates and numerous scandals For today's teenagers

and young adults years of ineffective and inefficient political leadership have completely eroded any sense that politicians or government have the ability to do good or effect positive change Worse the mean spirited dysfunctional political system that has come to characterize American politics has turned young people off to the idea of running for office With more than 500 000 elected positions in the United States what will happen when this generation is expected to take the reins of political power Through an original national survey of more than 4 000 high school and college students as well as more than 100 in depth interviews Jennifer L Lawless and Richard L Fox find that young Americans feel completely alienated from contemporary politics and express little ambition or aspiration to run for office in the future The overwhelming majority see nothing particularly noble about those currently in office viewing most as dishonest self interested and disinterested in helping their constituents These young people want to improve their communities and enact change in the world but they don t think politics is the way to achieve these goals In fact they look disdainfully upon the prospects of growing up to be a mayor governor senator or even president of the United States Running from Office explores young people s opinions about contemporary politics and their political ambition or lack of it The book paints a political profile of the next generation that should sound alarm bells about the long term deeply embedded damage contemporary politics has wrought on U S democracy and its youngest citizens As disheartening as their conclusions sound Lawless and Fox end with practical suggestions for how new technologies national service programs and well strategized public service campaigns could generate political ambition in young people Today s high school and college students care deeply about improving the future and it s not too late to ensure that they view running for office as an effective way to do so

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
