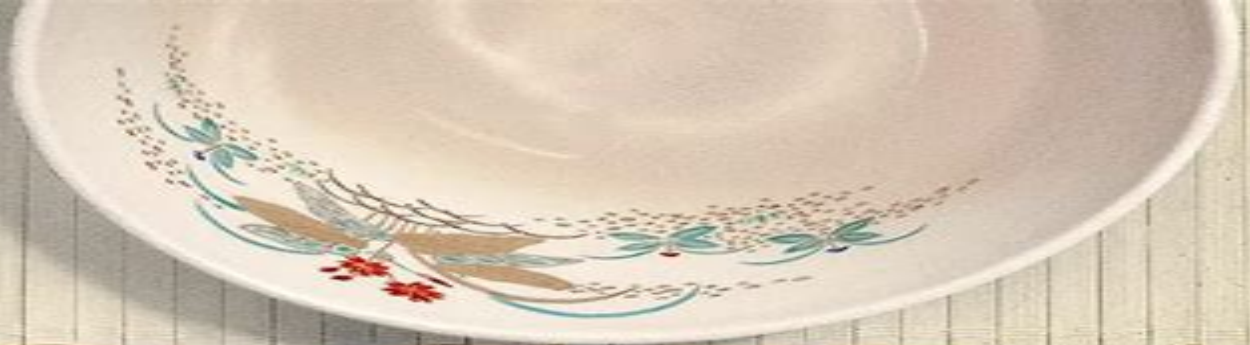

The Teacher Boy Sylvester Uzoigwe Okereke, 2024-08-08 In this book, Chief Sylvester Okereke uses the story of his life growing up in Eastern Nigeria to provide a first-hand account of several intriguing Igbo cultural practices such as the horse acquisition, chieftaincy title, the manhood rites, the women fattening, circumcision, marriage rites, and more. In a highly accessible manner, he recounts how his father encouraged him against challenges to pursue education at a time when it was little valued among the people of eastern Nigeria. As historical background, the author discusses the Anglo-Aro war of 1901-02, the conquering of eastern Nigeria by British colonialists in the early 1900s, the concept of warrant paramount chiefs introduced by Britain as an indirect rule measure in southern Nigeria, and the British shaping of rural communities in eastern Nigeria. He tells of his life in detail: his travail in boarding homes in distant communities where he was sent for studies, the influence of cultural practices on his decision to go to school, and how he conquered these challenges. The book also covers his sojourn into politics as a young man of 21 and discusses the political structure at the time: county councils, native courts, district councils, and more.

Mandle,2000 Annotation When Joan Mandle accepted the position of Director of Women s Studies at Colgate University she had specific goals in mind to make the program stronger more academically rigorous and publicly open The program would resist becoming the captive of identity politics and would refuse to allow itself to become marginalized on the campus It would reach beyond the negative stereotypes of feminism on campus by appealing to and challenging all students and faculty interested in gender issues and social change Just as Mandle anticipated she faced obstacles during the transformation Among her critics were feminist students and faculty whose views of a successful program directly contradicted Mandle s While the new director called for outreach they insisted on isolation While she set forth a policy of inclusiveness they sought to maintain an exclusive community These individuals preferred the former model of the women s studies program despite its tendency toward separatism **Can We Wear Our Pearls and Still Be Feminists** explores women s studies from Mandle s perspective as a program director feminist activist and scholar She offers a vivid account of being forced to grapple with fundamental issues of what women s studies is and should be Her strong commitment to feminism and women s studies does not prevent her from voicing her concerns instead it compells her to share the story of her directorship in hopes of shedding light on the strengths and weaknesses pitfalls and triumphs of women s studies as an academic discipline Through her examination of the battles involved in creating an academically significant and ideologically open program Mandle provides insight into a possible avenue of change for feminism By showing how the program at Colgate University was able to encourage campuswide discussions on feminism Mandle demonstrates that women s studies can succeed as an inclusive and rigorous field This enlightening memoir provides readers with a window on important debates concerning feminism and women in academia **María Magdalena Campos-Pons** Carmen
