THE ALTERNATE DEFENSE PRE-SENTENCE INVESTIGATION REPORT: TEMPERING HARSH STATE SENTENCING RECOMMENDATIONS

In the Wiscousia circuit-court system, judges in followy cases may order that a presentence investigation (PSI) report be generated by a probation/passic agent from the Department of Corrections (DOC) so that the count has the follow understanding possible of the defendant's life and circumstances at sentencing. This, of course, is so that the court will be able to make the most fully-informed and fairest dispositional decision possible. At times, PSI reports prepared by state corrections agents recommend prison sentences which are harsher than what the prosecutors recommend. One way of attalionating an under prison sentence recommendation in a court-ordered PSI report is for the definate to present its own alternate PSI report for the judge's information and consideration at sentencing. The Amatomy of a Pre-Sentence Investigation Report

In Wisconsin's state counts, a PSI report normally consists of two parts.

First is a state-mandated cover theet containing the basic personal information about the defendant, such as date of birth, sex, height, and weight and information about the county circuit court involved and the charged offense(s).
