Pierre-Auguste Renoir (1841-1919) Ambroise Vollard, 2015-01-10 RENOIR par Ambroise Vollard est un texte de référence sur l'artiste par un contemporain engagé dans l'aventure de la peinture de son époque. Ambroise Vollard 1866-1939 est d'abord un marchand d'art précurseur et célèbre mais il est aussi un crivain constamment redit depuis 1920. Il a suivi l'artiste comme marchand et comme confident de 1894 à sa mort en 1919. Il a noté ses conversations avec Renoir et a écrit ensuite une biographie qui a fait date. Rédigé le plus souvent sous forme de dialogue, son texte est particulièrement vivant et intéressant. L'édition enrichie de VisiMuZ rajoute au texte intégral de la biographie plus de 200 photos de tableaux agrandissables en plein cran par simple tap. Pour chacune, les dimensions, la localisation, musée, collection sont précisées. Cette édition est donc la fois un livre de la catégorie beaux-arts et une biographie de référence. Le lecteur voit apparaître les différents tableaux au fur et mesure de sa lecture, peut les consulter en plein cran et les agrandir plus encore pour regarder un détail. Outre les illustrations, ces textes de référence sont complétés par d'autres anecdotes issues des biographies de Georges Rivière et Jean Renoir et des commentaires VisiMuZ. En replaçant les tableaux dans le contexte global de l'œuvre de l'artiste, en faisant comprendre au lecteur l'évolution artistique du peintre, VisiMuZ rend sa biographie plus attrayante et pédagogique. Pour un livre d'art, voici au moins 5 bonnes raisons de préférer un livre numérique au papier : disponibilité permanente, où que vous soyez, avec un encombrement minimal, adaptation de la taille des caractères, la vue de chacun, agrandissement des photos pour mise en valeur des détails, création d'une photothèque personnelle avec les photos de l'ebook, tableaux mis en valeur encadrés par la tablette.
