SNS is also known as social network service. Today, adolescents make use of lots of ways online to communicate with people, such as Wall Post, Status Update, Activity Feed, Thumbs Up, and Profile. These are the features of SNSs, such as Facebook and Myplace. SNS are part of a suite of Web applications, also called social media, which utilize Web 2.0 principles.

"The term Web 2.0 defines websites that are designed to: (a) rely on the participation of mass groups of users rather than centrally controlled content providers, (b) aggregate and remix content from multiple sources, and (c) more intensely network users and content together" (O'Reilly, 2007). There are a large number of adolescents using social media. For example, "a national survey in 2009 finds that 73% of online teenagers use SNS, which is an increase from 55% 3 years earlier" (Lenhart, Purcell, Smith, and Zickuhr, 2010).

The rise of network technology had a profound impact on human communication. It produces a new type of interaction between people - network contacts. Network contacts refer to interaction on the network and certain social relationships during the communication process (John December, 1996). On this basis, the subject of network
