central role not only in epistemology but in the philosophy of mind and language as well Just as tradition holds that you believe and assert propositions you can believe and assert probabilistic contents Accepting that we can believe assert and know probabilistic contents has significant consequences for many philosophical debates including debates about the relationship between full belief and credence the semantics of epistemic modals and conditionals the contents of perceptual experience peer disagreement pragmatic encroachment perceptual dogmatism and transformative experience In addition accepting probabilistic knowledge can help us discredit negative evaluations of female speech explain why merely statistical evidence is insufficient for legal proof and identify epistemic norms violated by acts of racial profiling Hence the central theses of this book not only help us better understand the nature of our own mental states but also help us better understand the nature of our responsibilities to each other
