FairPoint strikers to start voting on new contract

FairPoint employees will begin voting on a new contract with the company on Monday. The union, which represents about 1,000 employees, has been in a contract dispute with the company since 2008. The new contract would provide for a 3 percent wage increase over the next three years, as well as other benefits. The union is seeking a 5 percent increase, but the company has offered 3 percent. The vote will be held on Monday, and the results will be announced on Tuesday.

Let's go, goes governor group that pushes off-shore drilling


