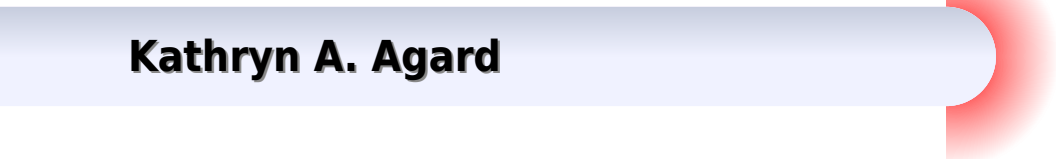


Board of Directors Responsibilities
