Christmas: Its Origin and Associations William Francis Dawson,2019-06-03 In looking at the celebrations of Christmas at different periods and in different places I have observed that whatever views men hold respecting Christ they all agree that His Advent is to be hailed with joy and the nearer the forms of festivity have approximated to the teaching of Him who is celebrated the more real has been the joy of those who have taken part in the celebrations My aim is neither critical nor apologetic but historical and pictorial it is not to say what might or ought to have been but to set forth from extant records what has actually taken place to give an account of the origin and hallowed associations of Christmas and to depict by pen and pencil the important historical events and interesting festivities of Christmastide With materials collected from different parts of the world and from writings both ancient and modern I have endeavored to give in the present work a chronological account of the celebrations and observances of Christmas

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
