The sentences/phrases that are used are linking phrases and paragraphs, for example: However... Then... In contrast... They...

Subject/Topic Agreement

For example: The dinosaur has a tail. However, it has a tail.

Technical Language

The language included needs to describe that is specific to the particular topic or theme that is being written. When writing about dinosaurs, the technical language would be subject to the particular topic, for example: extinct, fossils, dinosaurs.

Explicit Present Tense

For example: Fish come up to the surface of the water to breathe.

Researching, organising, taking notes, summarising and referencing.
