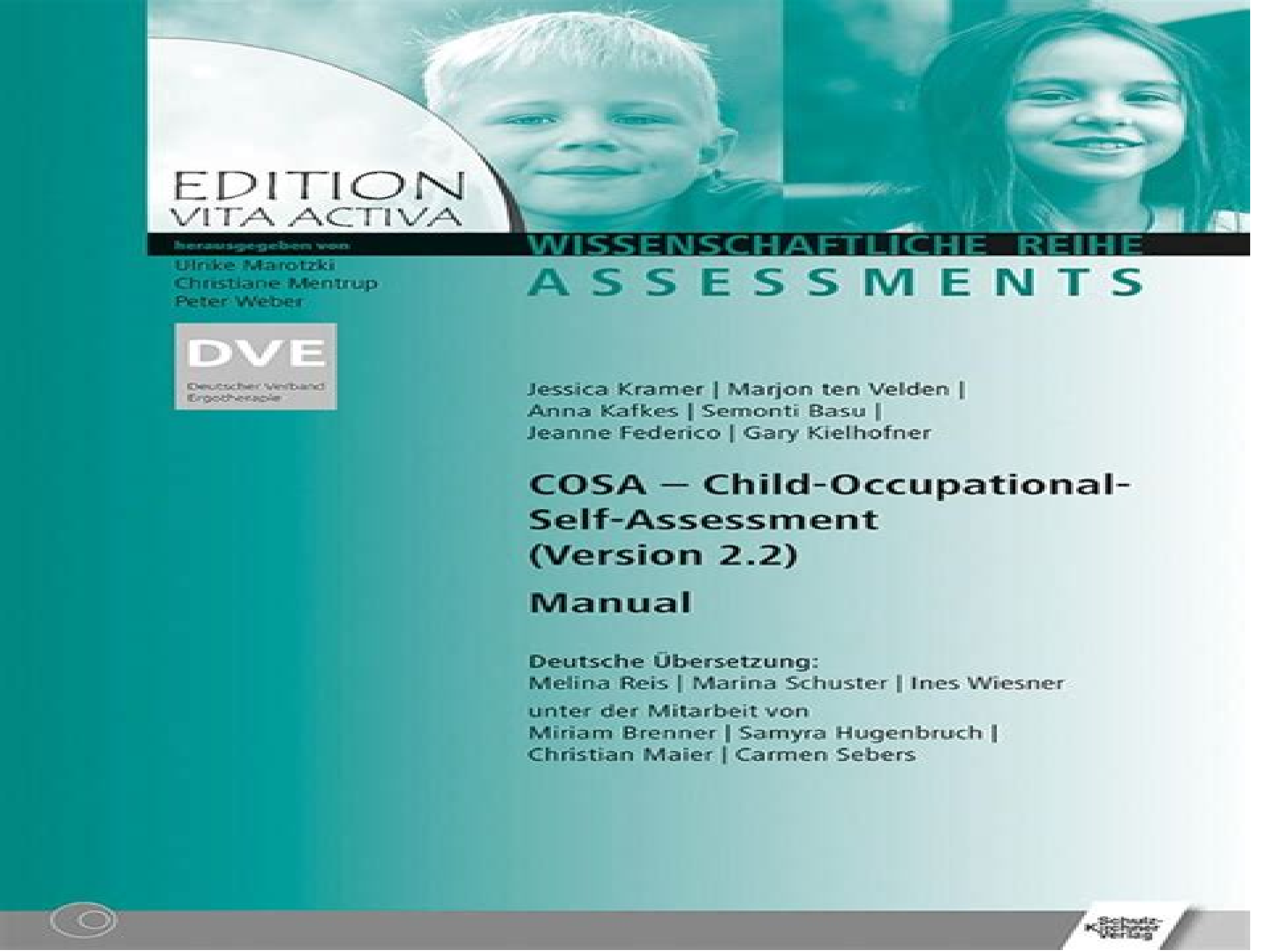

Das Assessment umfasst 25 Items zu Aktivitäten des täglichen Lebens, denen junge Menschen in verschiedenen Kontexten nachgehen können. Die COSA Items beziehen sich auf folgende Betätigungsbereiche: Selbstversorgung, Spiel, Freizeit, Lernen. Das Manual enthält unterschiedliche Modifizierungen, um das COSA individuell an den jungen Menschen und seine Fähigkeiten anzupassen.
