The Status of Student Involvement in University Governance in Kenya Mulinge, Munyae M., Arasa, Josephine N., 2017-05-05 This book examines the concept of the democratization of governance in universities in Kenya with particular emphasis on students involvement in governance processes and decision making Data were collected from members of the student community utilizing a structured self administered questionnaire and from purposively selected key informants and focus group discussants drawn from Kenyatta University representing the public sector and the United States International University representing the private sector The guiding argument for the study was that shared governance one of the principles of good governance is critical in enabling the universities to deliver their visions and the missions effectively The results revealed that while in principle Kenyan universities have embraced democratic governance in which all stakeholders including students have a role to play in practice they continue to violate the core principles of good governance particularly shared governance Specifically students who are major stakeholders in university education are largely excluded from significant structures of governance thereby limiting their influence and participation Although their representation is mainly provided via student self governance organs unions associations and or councils their effectiveness is undermined considerably by the lack of trust and confidence of the student body and the unending manipulation by top university administrators and external political actors Student active involvement in decision making is mainly confined to lower levels such as the school faculty and departmental programme The authors call for a paradigm shift in the involvement of students in the governance of universities in ways that discourage the current culture of tokenism and political correctness that characterizes public and private universities in Kenya

The Oxford Handbook of Johannine Studies Judith M. Lieu, Martinus C. de Boer, 2018-07-19 The contribution of the Johannine literature to the development of Christian theology and particularly to Christology is uncontested although careful distinction between the implications of its language especially that of sonship in
