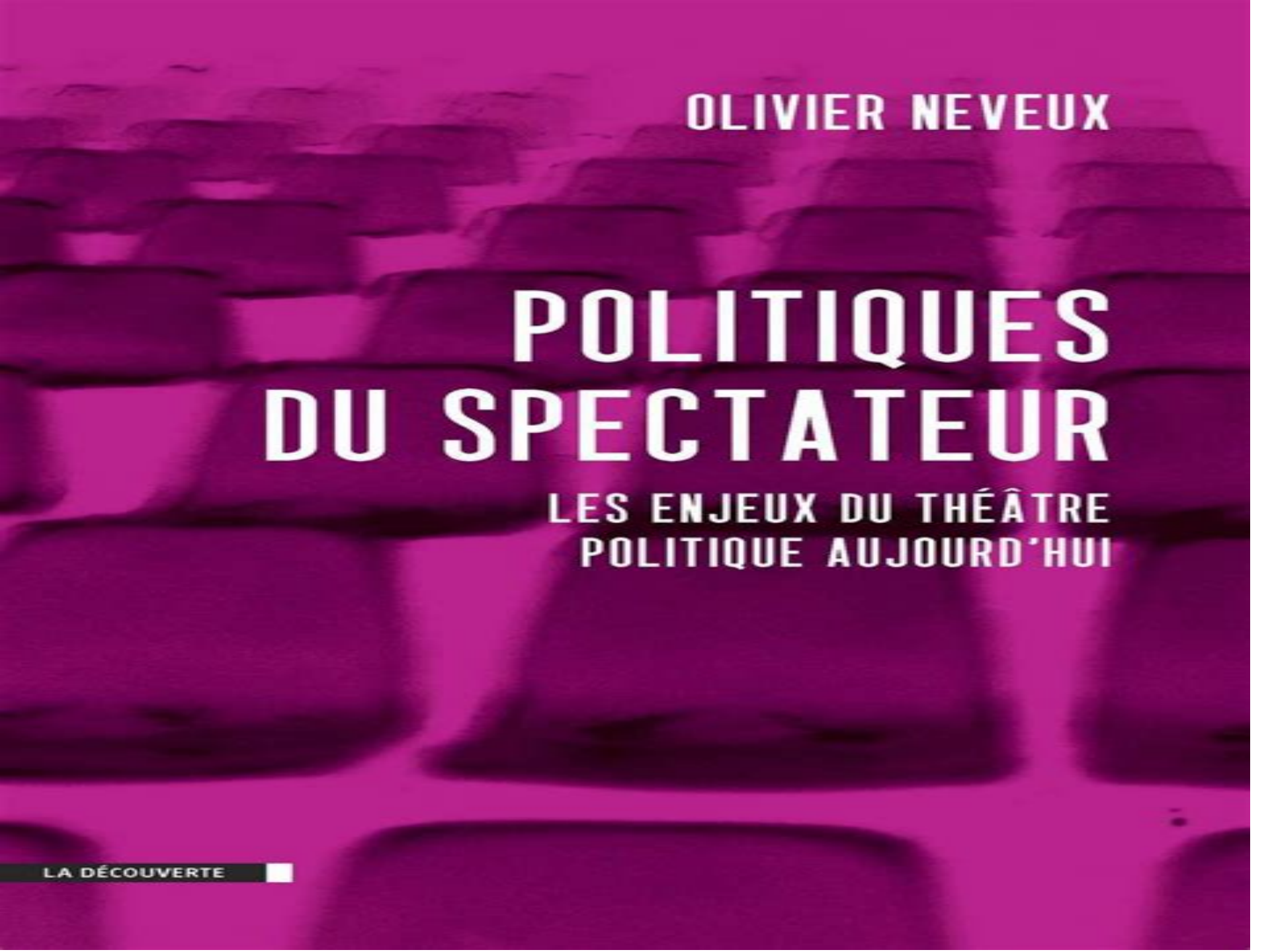

The Social History of Ideas in Quebec, 1760-1896 Yvan Lamonde, 2013-05-01 In *The Social History of Ideas in Quebec 1760-1896* Yvan Lamonde traces the province's political and intellectual development from the British Conquest to the election of Prime Minister Wilfrid Laurier From the individuals who formulated them to the networks in which they circulated to their reception Yvan Lamonde focuses on ideas at work and their role in shaping Quebec history The mapping of a complete intellectual circuit allows Lamonde to follow the strains of ideological debates monarchism liberalism republicanism democracy revolution ultramontanism nationalism over more than a century His work is informed by an encyclopaedic reading of the print culture of the period and the book conveys a profound and nuanced knowledge of the social context and cultural channels educational institutions newspapers the book trade in which intellectual debate occurred Lamonde argues that while these ideas concerned politics they went beyond the political they were a fundamental and everyday element of civic society that was expressed in the public sphere through pamphlets the popular press and sermons Lamonde's scrutiny of public opinion in Quebec allows him to place such currents of thought in the colony's international context that of France England Rome the United States and their respective metropolises *The Social History of Ideas in Quebec 1760-1896* covers a volatile time in the province's history from the end of the French Regime through the American invasion the War of 1812 and the Rebellions in Lower Canada capturing the cultural ascension of a society and the foundations of Quebec identity

The Intellectual Origins of the Belgian

Revolution Stefaan Marteel, 2018-09-05 This book explores the political ideas of the Belgian Revolution of 1830 which led to the break up of the Restoration state of the united Kingdom of the Netherlands It uncovers the origins of liberalism and political Catholicism in the Southern Netherlands in the wake of the French Revolution and traces the development of political language in the context of the tensions between the Northern and Southern part of the united Netherlands It shows how differences in Dutch and Belgian political and intellectual history resulted in different understandings of essential political concepts such as sovereignty and balance of powers as well as of the nature of the constitutional order of 1815 Finally it traces the emergence of Belgian nationalism within the discourse of opposition against the government Stefaan Marteel therefore provides a fresh perspective on the intellectual background of the rise of the nation state in the nineteenth century

Re-Situating Public Theatre in Contemporary France Ifigenia Gonis, 2023-05-10 This book examines the dynamics of the relational and spatial politics of contemporary French theatrical production with a focus on four theatres in the Greater Paris region It situates these dynamics within the intersection of the histories of the public theatre and theatre decentralization in France and the dialogues between live performances and the larger frameworks of artistic direction and programming as well as various imaginations of the public Understanding these phenomena as well as the politics that underscore them is key to understanding not only the present status of the public theatre in France but also how theatre as a publicly funded institution interacts with the notion of the plurality rather than the homogeneity of its publics

Race and Theatre in France, 2025-08-26 These well researched essays speak to the situation of African descended artists on the French stage especially in prestigious government subsidized theatres Through documentation historical analysis close attention to productions and witnessing by Black French speaking artists Chalaye uncovers and critiques the unacknowledged racialization and racism that have circumscribed the careers of Black actors She ascribes responsibility for this frustrating situation in large part to the
