Priestley's Progress Mike Bullock, 2017-07-07 This first ever biography of Antarctic explorer Sir Raymond Priestley 1886 1974 covers his full at times life threatening involvement with Sir Ernest Shackleton's 1907 1909 Nimrod Expedition and Robert Scott's 1910 1913 Terra Nova Expedition Priestley's service with the British 46th Division during World War I won him the Military Cross for gallantry After the war he played a leading role in establishing the Scott Polar Research Institute at the University of Cambridge He was later appointed vice chancellor of the University of Melbourne and then of the University of Birmingham and also helped establish the University of the West Indies He received a knighthood for his services to education During retirement a misnomer in his case he went with the Duke of Edinburgh on the Royal Yacht Britannia as an Antarctic expert and joined the American Deep Freeze IV Expedition during his tenure directing the British Antarctic Survey Despite the demands of his career Priestley remained an involved family man throughout
