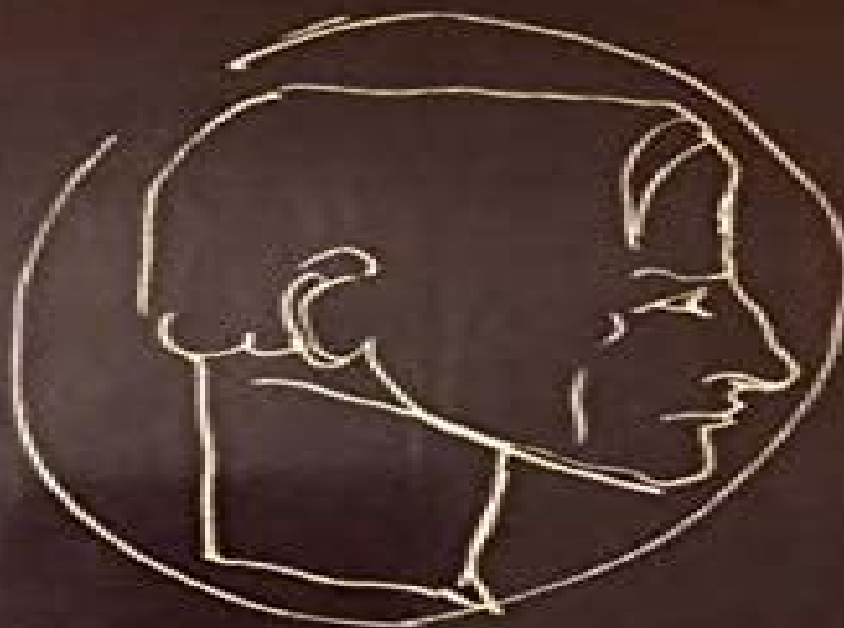

to put Pound's poetry at the heart of his existence where he himself placed it and to view his extraordinarily active life, his loves and his creative effort as a single complex drama. The altogether new and comprehensive account of all of his poems from the earliest through *Cathay* and up to *Hugh Selwyn Mauberley* and the first *Cantos* will illuminate his poetry and make it more accessible. With that, there is an exceptionally clear and cogent analysis of the ideas informing his Imagisme and his Vorticism and of the ideas informing his commitments to the freedom and fulfilment of the individual to a cultural renaissance and to social and economic reform. The second volume *The Epic Years* carries on the narrative of his life and works from 1921, the year in which he took up residence in Paris.
