A sample is progressively desolvated, atomized and ionized. The torch is operated at atmospheric pressure. To reach the reduced pressures of mass spectrometers ions are extracted through a series of two approximately one millimeter wide circular apertures set in water cooled metal cones. The space between the cones is evacuated to approximately one torr. The space behind the second cone is pumped down to or near to the pressure needed for the mass spectrometer MS. The first cone called the sampler is placed directly in the plasma plume and its position is adjusted to the point where atomic ions are most abundant. The hot plasma gas expands through the sampler orifice and in this expansion is placed the second cone called the skimmer. After the skimmer traditional MS designs are employed i.e. quadrupoles, magnetic sectors, time of flight. ICP MS is the leading trace
