throughout this book is on the continuity of Russian policies during the early modern period 1450 1800 and that those policies coincided with those of other successful contemporary Eurasian polities The continuities occurred in the midst of constant change but neither one nor the other continuities or changes alone can account for Russia's success Instead Russian rulers from Ivan III to Catherine II with their hub advisors managed to sustain a balance between the two During the early modern period these Russian rulers invited into the country foreign experts to facilitate the transfer of technology and know how mostly from Europe but also from Asia In this respect they were willing to look abroad for solutions to domestic problems Russia looked westward for military weaponry and techniques at the same time it was expanding eastward into the Eurasian heartland The ruling elite and by extension the entire ruling class worked in cooperation with the ruler to implement policies The Church played an active role in supporting the government and in seeking to eliminate opposition to the government The End of the Beginning W.J. Fash, 2020-03-31 Accounts of the rise of American literature often start in the 1850s with a cluster of great American novels Hawthorne's *The Scarlet Letter* Melville's *Moby Dick* and Stowe's *Uncle Tom's Cabin* But these great works did not spring fully formed from the heads of their creators All three relied on conventions of short fiction built up during the culture of beginnings the three decades following the War of 1812 when public figures glorified the American past and called for a patriotic national literature Decentering the novel as the favored form of early nineteenth century national literature Lydia Fash repositions the sketch and the tale at the center of accounts of American literary history revealing how cultural forces shaped short fiction that was subsequently mined for these celebrated midcentury novels and for the first novel published by an African American In the shorter works of writers such as Washington Irving Catharine Sedgwick Edgar Allan Poe and Lydia Maria Child among others the aesthetic of brevity enabled the beginning idea of a story to take the outsized importance fitted to the culture of beginnings Fash argues that these short forms with their ethnic exclusions and narrative innovations coached readers on how to think about the United States past and the nature of narrative time itself Combining history print history and literary criticism this book treats short fiction as a vital site for debate over what it meant to be American thereby offering a new account of the birth of a self consciously national literary tradition *The Old Testament Between Theology and History* Niels Peter Lemche, 2008-01-01 From its inception at the time of the Enlightenment until the mid twentieth century the historical critical method constituted the dominant paradigm in Old Testament studies In this magisterial overview Niels Peter Lemche surveys the development of the historical critical method and the way it changed the scholarly perception of the Old Testament In part 1 he describes the rise and influence of historical critical approaches while in part 2 he traces their decline and fall Then in part 3 he discusses the identity of the authors of the Old Testament based on the content of the literature they wrote demonstrating that the collapse of history does not preclude critical study

people of Israel and which reflect the life of the people in this period Therefore there is a reciprocal relationship between the writings or books of the Old Testament and the life of Israel in its history The understanding of the texts presupposes insights into the historical context and the development of the life of Israelite society while at the same time the texts themselves are the most important indeed for the most part the only source for it This Introduction attempts to take account of this reciprocal relationship The first part deals with the history of Israel However its approach differs from most accounts of this history It takes the Old Testament texts themselves as a starting point and first of all outlines the picture of historical developments and associations which the texts present An attempt is then made on this basis to reconstruct historical developments by introducing material from outside the Bible This method of working leads to close connections between the second and third parts because it has to take account of the nature and original purpose of the texts and their function within the biblical books as they are now The second part attempts to present the texts collected in the Old Testament as expressions of the life of Israel The third part discusses the books of the Old Testament in their present form
