Each player must have a ball and bring it to every practice and game. Put name on ball in permanent ink. Leather, hand-stitched ball is preferred. Do not purchase plastic balls. Balls need not be expensive. Players are to bring water bottles - filled with water - for all practices and games. Uniforms with issued socks are required for games. Socks must be worn over Shin guards. Shirts must be tucked in. Long hair must be restrained with soft bands.
