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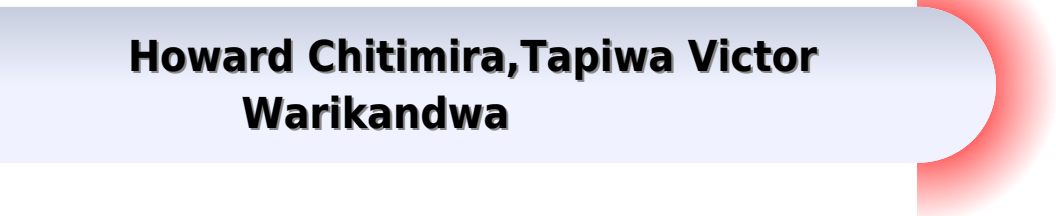

This slowdown was more pronounced in the first half of 2018 and it reflected weaker exports among the region's large oil exporters, Nigeria and Angola, due to dwindling oil production amid higher but volatile international prices for crude petroleum. A deeper contraction in Sudanese economic activity and a broad based growth slowdown among non resource intensive countries also played a role. Sub Saharan African countries with fragile context have made considerable efforts to find a way out of fragility.
