Mullis,1993 The National Assessment of Educational Progress NAEP 1992 reading assessment was administered to nationally representative samples of fourth eighth and twelfth grade students attending public and private schools and to state representative public school samples of fourth graders in 43 jurisdictions Nearly 140 000 students were assessed in all Data were summarized on the NAEP reading proficiency scale ranging from 0 to 500 and results were reported according to three achievement levels at each grade basic proficient and advanced Major findings were that 1 59%
