Definition: Language: An arbitrary, conventionalized, structured system of symbols that serves as the medium through which the signification of the world

→ Language is not only a tool for communication, it also serves as a means of socialization, as the terms used in it are used to shape the cognition of the world

- **code language**: a set of **conventionalized symbols** used to **communicate** that is **shared** by a **group** of **people** (codebooks, codes, shorthand, etc.)
- **code-switching**: the **process** of **switching** between **two** or **more** **languages** or **dialects** within a **single** **conversation**
- **code-switching family**: a **collection** of **languages** or **dialects** that **share** a **common** **ancestry** or **historical** **development**
