- The nucleophilic attack of the water occurs at the more substituted carbon atom.

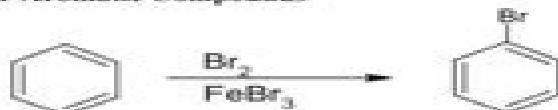
2. With Alkynes

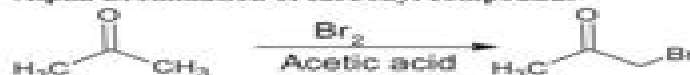


4. Photo halogenation of alkanes



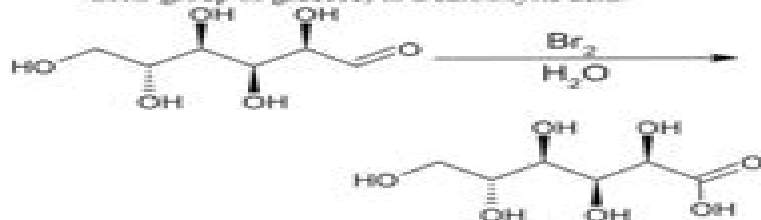

5. Alpha Bromination of carbonyl compounds



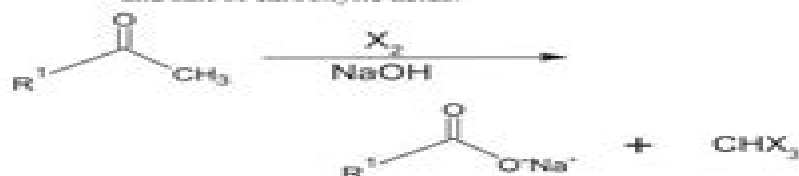
6. Oxidation of Monosaccharides

1. Bromine water is a mild oxidizing agent
2. selectively oxidizes the aldehyde group (for example CHO group of glucose) to a carboxylic acid.

1. converts methyl ketones to Haloform (CHX_3 ($X=Cl, Br, I$)) and salt of carboxylic acids.

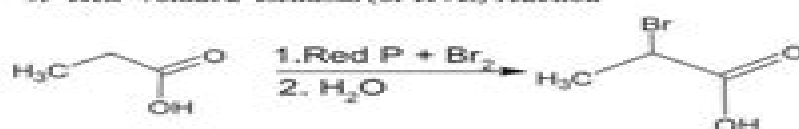


8. The Hoffmann Bromamide degradation

1. It converts primary amide to a primary amine with one less carbon atom.



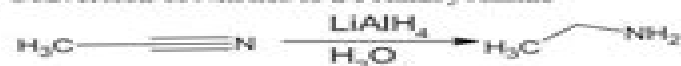

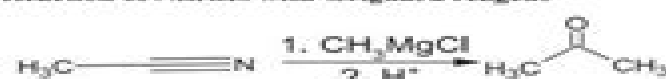
