Children are often easily discouraged by failures or when things don't turn out like they want. This lesson seeks to assist children in identifying responses to those situations that develop and reinforce healthy self-esteem.

Supplies Needed: poster boards, tape, dollar bill, shoe box, "I Can't Funeral", speaking parts, blank paper

Introduction: Introduce yourself and tell the students that you are from the Family Resource Center. Explain that the Family Resource Center is a place the helps people who have been abused. Abuse is when someone hurts another person on purpose. Identify different ways that someone can be abusive (hitting someone, name calling, etc.) We also get to talk to students in schools. Today we will be talking about self-esteem.
