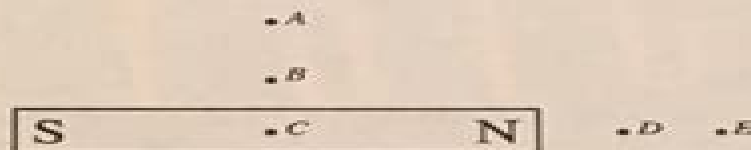


1. Answer the questions below on the basis of your experience with charges and magnets.

- how should the *strength* of the magnetic field at every point be reflected in the *magnetic field lines*?

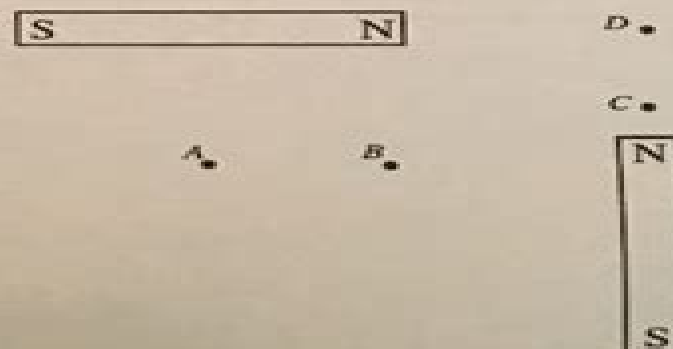
