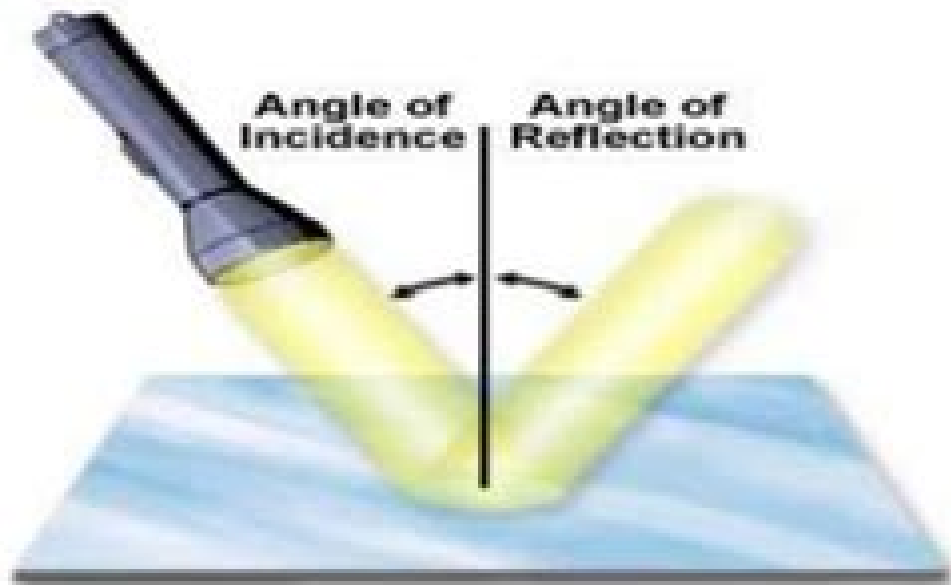


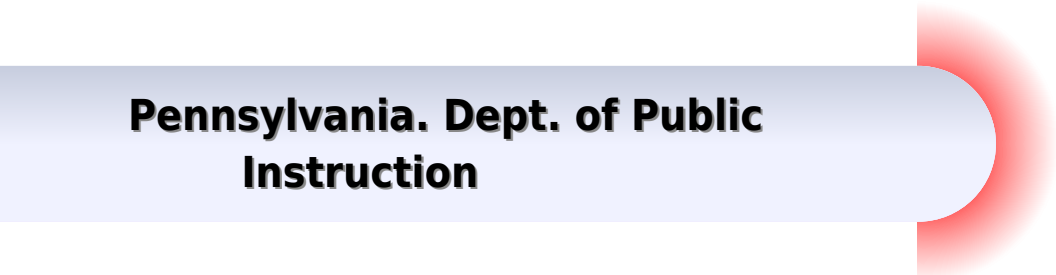
Reflection vs. Refraction
