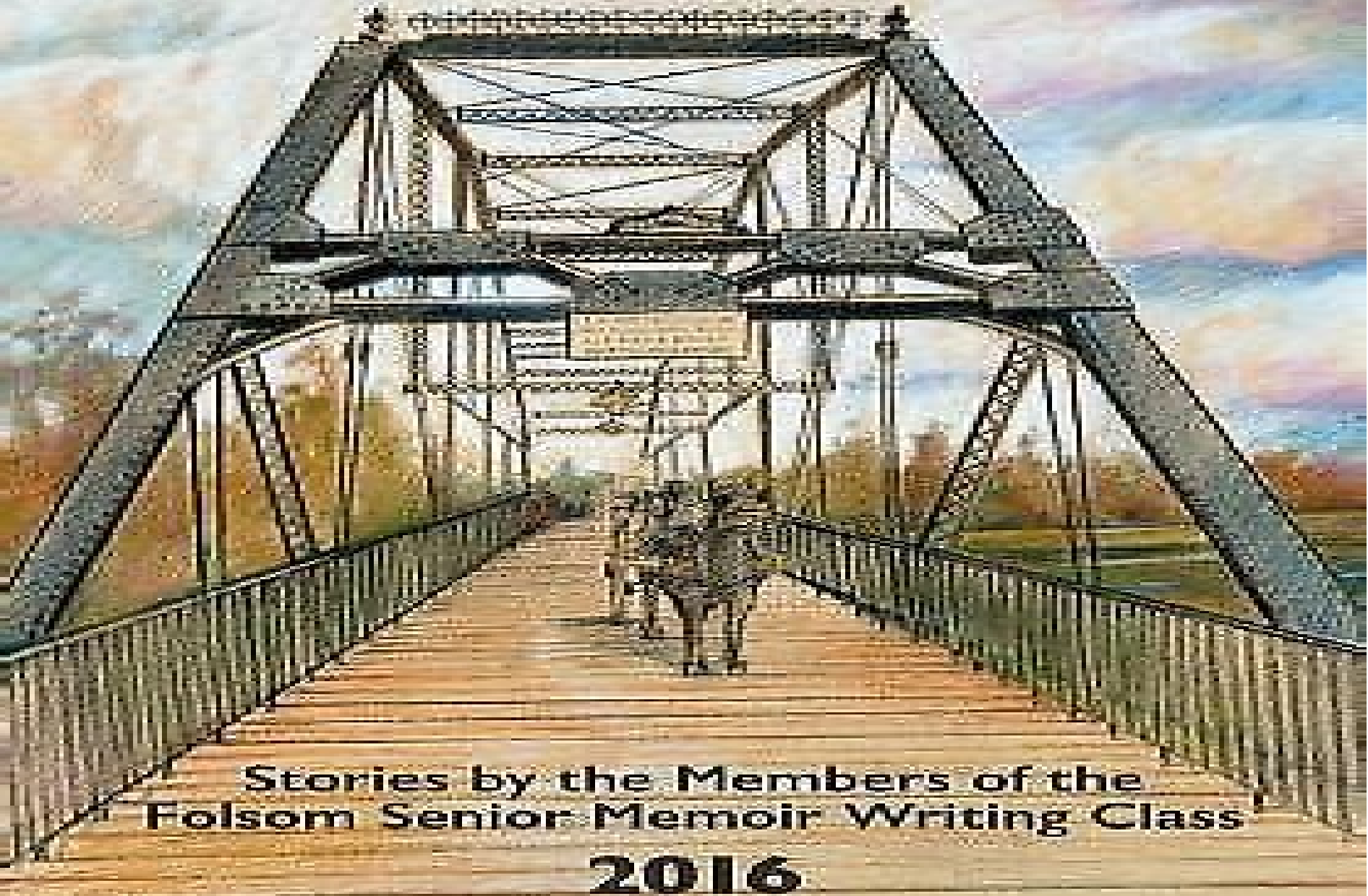

Newman organizes her narrators accounts by the themes of childhood marriage motherhood immigration and old age and considers a wide range of factors that shape the narration including audience intent choice of language and Jewish Muslim culture The result is a fascinating blend of analysis narration and history
