Sol Plaatje's Mhudi Sabata-mpho Mokae, Brian Willan, 2021 Sol Plaatje's Mhudi is the first full length novel in English to have been written by a black South African and is widely regarded as one of South Africa's most important literary works. Set in the 1830s it tells the tale of Mhudi and Ra Thaga a romantic story set against a violent backdrop of war between Barolong and Matebele complicated by the intrusions of Boer trekkers with whom the Barolong form an alliance. It is notable among other things for the way Plaatje uses the past to explore the roots of the oppression and injustice suffered by his people a century later when the book was written. Dear Comrade President André Odendaal, 2022-08-01 In his annual presidential address on 8 January 1986 ANC president Oliver Tambo called on South Africans to make apartheid ungovernable through armed action and militant struggle. But unknown to the world on that very day the quiet-spoken mathematics teacher and aspirant priest turned reluctant revolutionary had also set up a secret think tank in Lusaka which he named the Constitution Committee giving it an ad hoc unique exercise that had no precedent in the history of the movement. Knowing that all wars end at a negotiating table and judging the balance of forces to be moving in favour of the liberation movement Tambo wanted the ANC to hold the initiative after the fall of apartheid. Assisted by Pallo Jordan he instructed his new think tank to formulate the principles and draft the outlines of a constitution that could unite South Africa when the time came to talk in the fledgling days of freedom and democracy. The seven-member team including Albie Sachs Kader Asmal and Zola Skweyiya started deliberating and reporting to Tambo. In correspondence they typically addressed him as Dear Comrade President. President explains how the purposeful first steps were taken in the making of South Africa's Constitution Why and how did this process happen What were the first written words When and where were they put on paper By whom What values did they espouse And how did the committee's work fit into the broader struggle This book answers these questions in new paradigm shifting ways

Space and planning in secondary cities Lochner Marais, Verna Nel, 2019-09-01 Much of the urban research focuses on the large metropolitan areas in South Africa This book assesses spatial planning in the second tier cities of the country Secondary cities are vital as they perform essential regional and in some cases global economic roles and help to distribute the population of a country more evenly across its surface Apartheid planning left South African cities fragmented segregated and with low densities Post apartheid policies aim to reverse these realities by emphasising integration higher densities and upgrading Achieving these aims has been challenging and often the historical patterns continue The evidence shows that two opposing patterns prevail namely increased densities and continued urban sprawl This book presents ten case studies of spatial planning and spatial transformation in secondary cities of South Africa The book frames these case studies against complexity theory and suggests that the post apartheid response to apartheid planning represents a linear deviation from history The ten case studies then reveal how difficult it is for local decision makers to find appropriate responses and how current responses often result in contradictory results Often these cities are highly vulnerable and they find it difficult to plan in the context of uncertainty The book also highlights how these cities find it difficult to stand on their own against the influence of interest groups property developers mining companies traditional authorities other spheres of government The main reasons include weak municipal finance statements the dependence on national and provincial government for capital expenditure limited investment in infrastructure maintenance the lack of planning capacity the inability to implement plans and the unintended and sometimes contrary outcomes of post apartheid planning policies
