Tighe, 2014-02-24 This book deals with the complex cognitive processes involved in understanding two horizontal aspects of music perception melody and rhythm both separately and together Focusing on the tonal framework for pitch material in melodies the first section provides evidence that mere exposure to music organized in a particular way is sufficient to induce the auditory system to prepare itself to receive further input conforming to the patterns already experienced Its chapters also offer evidence concerning elaborations of those basic schemes that come about through specialized training in music Continuing themes from the first section such as the hypothesis that melodies must be treated as integral wholes and not mere collections of elements the second section discusses the integration of melody and rhythm In these chapters there is an underlying concern for clarifying the relation central to aesthetic questions between physical patterns of sound energy in the world and our psychological experience of them The chapters in the third section provide excellent examples of the new scientific literature that attempts to objectively study early musical abilities Their data establish that infants and young children are far more perceptive and skilled appreciators of music than was thought a decade ago [Analysing East Asian music. Mondrian's Philosophy of Visual Rhythm Eiichi Tosaki, 2017-11-15 This volume investigates the meaning of visual rhythm through Piet Mondrian's unique approach to understanding rhythm in the compositional structure of painting drawing reference from philosophy, aesthetics, and Zen culture Its innovation lies in its reappraisal of a forgotten definition of rhythm as stasis or composition which can be traced back to ancient Greek thought This conception of rhythm the book argues can be demonstrated in terms of pictorial strategy through analysis of East Asian painting and calligraphy with which Greek thought on rhythm has identifiable commonalities The book demonstrates how these ideas about rhythm draw together various threads of intellectual development in the visual arts that cross disparate aesthetic cultural practices

As an icon of early 20th Century Modernism Mondrian's neoplasticism is a serious painterly and philosophical achievement. In his painting Mondrian was deeply influenced by Theosophy which took its influence from Eastern aesthetics particularly East Asian and Indian thought. However Mondrian's approach to visual rhythm was so idiosyncratic that his contribution to studies of visual rhythm is often under recognized. This volume shows that a close inspection of Mondrian's own writing, thinking and painting has much to tell scholars about how to understand a long forgotten aspect of visual rhythm. Rodin's famous criticism of photography, athlete in motion is forever frozen, can be applied to Muybridge's zoopraxiscope, the Futurists' rendition of stroboscopic images and Duchamp's *Nude Descending a Staircase*. Through a comparative study between Mondrian's painting and these seminal works, this volume initiates a new convention for the cognition of the surface of painting as visual rhythm. Mondrian's simultaneous emphasis on the static and the rhythmic is hardly fodder for a publicist. Eiichi Tosaki has taken on the challenge of elucidating Mondrian's theories of rhythm and particularly his conception of static rhythm. The result is a tour de force that will forever alter the reader's encounter with the works of Mondrian.

Musical scores like literature, poetry, and technical manuals are documents. The central tenet of this book is that musical composition in the digital age is a form of document engineering. In essence, music shares with other forms of creative content generation, from poetry to prose and from science to science fiction, the need for structure, flow, and sources for creativity. Musical composition is considered in this book as the creative process of engineering musical documents with regards to its arrangement, form, texture, and instrumentation, etc. This document then instructs a performance or the creation

of an alternative document such as a recording In this book the arrangement of phrases patterns and structures seen in music will be illustrated to give new composers a starting point to begin planning and making decisions about their own compositions The book will also guide those who need assistance in completing a piece While this is a book about musical composition it is not meant to be a manual on music theory Instead the book keeps its focus on the structural elements of a composition Its aim is to give the audience a structural road map for composing whether they are starting a piece from the first note having a melody in mind already or need help overcoming a creative hurdle The book examines compositions that clearly define a form or technique Among the key compositional elements are Form Phrase Period and Expression in Composition Rhythm Motive Melody and Harmony Tonal Center Mode Mixture and Modulation Accompaniment Instrumentation Orchestration Composition Techniques and Notation Targeted examples cover all stages of writing a piece helping to build the reader's composition from the first note into a complete work without promoting a style or harmonic practice Each chapter contains a sidebar addressing helping the composer to add creative sources for the music making process Finally the book concludes with a chapter on creativity in terms of how composed music can affect our lives and even our fairy tales

The Evolution of Rhythm Cognition: Timing in Music and Speech Andrea Ravignani, Henkjan Honing, Sonja A. Kotz, 2018-07-24 Human speech and music share a number of similarities and differences One of the closest similarities is their temporal nature as both i develop over time ii form sequences of temporal intervals possibly differing in duration and acoustical marking by different spectral properties which are perceived as a rhythm and iii generate metrical expectations Human brains are particularly efficient in perceiving producing and processing fine rhythmic information in music and speech However a number of critical questions remain to be answered Where does this human sensitivity for rhythm arise How did rhythm cognition develop in human evolution How did environmental rhythms affect the evolution of brain rhythms Which rhythm specific neural circuits are shared between speech and music or even with other domains Evolutionary processes long time scales often prevent direct observation understanding the psychology of rhythm and its evolution requires a close fitting integration of different perspectives First empirical observations of music and speech in the field are contrasted and generate testable hypotheses Experiments exploring linguistic and musical rhythm are performed across sensory modalities ages and animal species to address questions about domain specificity development and an evolutionary path of rhythm Finally experimental insights are integrated via synthetic modeling generating testable predictions about brain oscillations underlying rhythm cognition and its evolution Our understanding of the cognitive neurobiological and evolutionary bases of rhythm is rapidly increasing However researchers in different fields often work on parallel potentially converging strands with little mutual awareness This research topic builds a bridge across several disciplines focusing on the cognitive neuroscience of rhythm as an evolutionary process It includes contributions encompassing although not limited to 1 developmental and comparative studies of rhythm e g critical acquisition periods

innateness 2 evidence of rhythmic behavior in other species both spontaneous and in controlled experiments 3 comparisons of rhythm processing in music and speech e g behavioral experiments systems neuroscience perspectives on music speech networks 4 evidence on rhythm processing across modalities and domains 5 studies on rhythm in interaction and context social affective etc 6 mathematical and computational e g connectionist symbolic models of rhythmicity as an evolved behavior
